A. THE RESOLUTION ON THE PUBLIC LECTURES

The 39th BMC consultation held in Highveld and Swaziland District, notes that 2015 is an important occasion in the life of the BMC as the formation within the MCSA. The BMC will be 40 years old in 2015.

As we look back with deep sense of gratitude to what God has done through the BMC movement in the life of the MCSA and society at large, we give glory to God. We commit to make 2015 to be the year of celebration, re-commitment and rededication to what the BMC stands for, in its vision and mission.

We therefore hereby move that:

- That throughout 2015 calendar year time be set aside, to celebrate the life of the BMC by celebrating those who led us in these 40years;
- That celebrations would be centered around those who served the BMC as Chairpersons and their executives;
- That, the Districts where these chairpersons reside would be tasked to assist the Connexional EXCO and collaborate with Local Churches to organize: Public Lecture and Worship Services to celebrate their contributions as we give glory to God for the 40years of the information, formation and transformation ... ‘the MCSA lefa labatswadi barona’

- That the Connexional Executive be tasked to set up a Connexional Committee on the 40years celebration in order to plan and execute this ‘40 Year Celebratory Program’

RESPONSE TO THE ABOVE NOTICE OF MOTION

The gesture of celebration is welcomed, 40 years is biblical, spiritual significant. This should be celebration of the Movement *and not the Chairpersons* and where the Chairperson is mentioned his Executive Committee should be included

- Identifying guest speakers and they should submit papers;
- Distribution of past chairpersons names and committees across all districts, so that we can all participate

C. THE SCOPE OF WORK

Coordinate, plan, oversee and execute the BMC 40th Celebration as a movement through the Public Lectures centered on the past BMC Connexional Chairpersons and their teams in partnership with District Executives and or delegated nominees or liaison and Local Churches where the past BMC Connexional Chairpersons are currently residing:

- i. To develop a timetable or schedule for all the Public Lectures as from February, 2015 up until November 2016, as at the latest – possible to be presented for adoption at the February 2015 BMC Connexional Meeting;
 - a. Such Time Table *to specify the date, venue and time* for the Public Lecture agreed with Local Church, Hosting District and the relevant past BMC Connexional Chairperson;
- ii. To prepare and deliver all logistics pertaining to the promotion and or marketing of the Public Lectures (not limited) but including – invitations (heading the list are the collective teams that led with the relevant Chairperson), submission of the presented lecture to the Connexional Office for compilation into later Publication, possible some pictures (to be uploaded to the website);

- iii. To recommend the name of a person who is best/most suited to do the research and deliver the Public Lecture on various Past Chairpersons and their collective teams; **Options to Explore include** –
 - a. Engaging the Past BMC Chairpersons individually and obtaining their thoughts/inputs/opinions on who is most suitable, maybe based on the extent of exposure into own leadership of the BMC, full-circle ministry and contribution into the Church and broader society
 - b. May consider immediate successors to each Chairperson ... (*age and resources may limit, in this instance Rev Dr S Mogoba would have to do Rev Baartman ... consider travelling and age as a limitation; some succession issues may limit quality of output*),
 - c. The Current Chair to deliver all the Public Lectures (*no personnel/staffing on BMC working as full-time in office, no full time researcher either for the BMC, meaning time and capacity may constrain ...*)
 - d. ETC – May Generate more and or other options
- iv. To ensure the Public Lectures celebrate 40years of BMC as a movement, therefore also serve as a revival for the BMC, creating moments of thinking and reflecting together on the Life of the BMC for the past 40years and going forward; research papers to be delivered in Public Lectures are –
 - a. To be centered around Chairpersons and their leadership collectives, in particular life of the BMC during their leadership; critical success factors for the BMC during those years, major initiatives and key BMC contributions to the life of the Church during that era (leadership season),
 - b. To provide a narrative of how the BMC allowed and or enabled Black people to be catalysts, free/liberated, informed, formed, transformed, effective, lead ... (*not only in Church but Society at large, ... it could be argued that 'BMC formed leaders and contributed them as a gift to the Society'*)

- v. To ensure full involvement of the Local Church where the Past Chairpersons are residing including Circuit Executive, Society Leadership, Local Notices and observance of the Public Lecture, announcements in Ministerial Retreats of the hosting District, etc
